green of the Juniper. The front door is framed by the Carolina Sapphire Cypress Pom Pom Topiaries. The yard also includes Chinese fringe flowers (Loropetalum), dark pink Curcuma, Society Garlic, Sunshine Ligustrum, Sago Palms, Camellias, Caladiums as well as pink Crape Myrtles.
