#### **Covenants Corner:**

#### **Tree cutting**

As per the covenants:

"Each lot owner must protect the wooded appearance of his lot, cutting only those trees necessary for construction of improvements and those trees which die and create a hazard. Unnecessary cutting of trees 6" in diameter and larger shall result in a fine of \$100 per tree."

One reason people move to Magnolia Forest is because of the large lots with many trees. Still, there are good reasons to cut down big trees such as disease or damage. If you have any questions, contact Bob Meltz. Thank you for your attention to this.

#### **Waste Management Update**

The new contract with Waste Management went into effect on April 1st. The new contract is reflected in the new pricing, and also in the new 96 gallon recycling bins. Recycling pickup is now every other Wednesday with the first date being April 2nd.

Please refer to the January-February newsletter for recycling guidance from WM. Place all recycling material in the 96 gallon bin. Nothing outside of the bin will be picked up. Also, please break down any cardboard boxes.

#### **Glass Recycling Coming to Slidell**

The city of Slidell has announced the April launch of a glass recycling program for residents.

This service will start on Saturday, April 12th and continue every 2nd Saturday of the month. Residents can drop off their recyclable glass at the designated recycling site in the Heritage Park parking lot at the corner of Pennsylvania Avenue and Bayou Lane. Drop off must be made between 9 am and noon.

This service is not restricted to city of Slidell residents but is available to anyone.

This service is a joint effort between the city of Slidell, Keep Slidell Beautiful, Coastal Environmental Services, Glass Half Full and Lemon Tree Recycling.
